**President's Report** - Lauren began the meeting by sharing that the board met last month to discuss some new spring activities while adhering to safety guidelines. You can find the ideas shared by the board on the PTG website under tab titled Minutes.

Lauren also provided an update on the new curtain track for the Allenwood stage. Ms. Laurie received an updated quote and the price remained the same from last year. Proceeds from Mr. Allen's Artsonia program and the Theatre Club's fundraiser last year will fund this project. Therefore, we will be moving forward with this capital project. Ordering and installation will be coordinated by the BOE. That means that the BOE will also be making the purchase and the PTG will make a donation or reimbursement to the BOE.
