



After School Enrichment: Volunteers needed to help supervise after school activities such as Yoga, Hip Hop, Mad Science as directed by the Chairperson. **Chairperson Position Available.**

Art Show: (several volunteers needed) Volunteers are needed later in the school day to help set up tables, organize the displays and monitor the students as they walk through the cafeteria to view the exhibits.

Allergy Committee: Volunteers are needed for several of our school events throughout the year. The committee coordinates the collection and distribution of teal pumpkin items for our Trunk or Treat event, works with the PTG to ensure that safe food items are available at all school events, and plans the annual Allenwood Safety Fair in June.

Bake Sale: Volunteers to provide an assortment of packaged baked goods to be sold at after school functions (BYOP, May Fair, etc.)

Book Fair: (many volunteers needed) Volunteers needed to help set up and break down the fair. Volunteers will also help on shopping days by helping the younger grades pick books. Two fairs held (Fall/Spring).

B.Y.O.P. Event: (aka Bring Your Own Pumpkin) Volunteers will be needed to set up, decorate, work check in, chaperone & clean up. Event held in October. **Co-Chair Position Available.**

Class Parent Organizer: (one per class) This job requires frequent contact with the teacher to organize the parties taking place over the year. Act as a liaison between teachers and parents.

Community Service Committee: This committee will help collect and organize various drives (food, clothing, blankets, etc.). Volunteers will be needed to collect and transport items to different organizations in need.

Dragon's Den School Store: Volunteers will be asked to help at the Dragon's Den School Store. The store is open 2 days for each sale, 3

times per school year during lunch hours of 11 am-1:10 pm. Volunteers would be needed to help set up, price items, help the children with purchases and break down.

Family Fun Events: Volunteers needed to plan events such as ice skating, ice cream social, etc. **Co-Chairperson Position Available.**

Field Day: (several volunteers needed) Volunteers are needed to help run stations in the morning and afternoon sessions. Volunteers are needed to distribute refreshments.

Fifth Grade Farewell: Volunteers are needed to help sort, stuff & deliver all "Fifth Grade Farewell" cards to our 5th graders who will soon be leaving Allenwood School. You will be contacted in the Spring by 5th grade Chairperson. In addition, volunteers will be needed to help organize and run the 5th grade end of year/farewell party.

Holiday Shoppe: Volunteers are needed to schedule volunteers, price items, set up & assist students with purchases. Held late November/December.

May Fair: (many volunteers needed) Come help with the ticket sales, set up, break down, staffing a game, food court, raffle baskets, etc. You'll be contacted in the spring by committee member. **Chairperson Position Available.**

Mixed Bag Designs Fundraiser: Help collect order forms and distribute product upon arrival as directed by the Chairperson.

On-Call Volunteer: If you are not sure right now how you can help but would like to be involved in the future, your name can go on our "On-Call" volunteer list. If we are shorthanded for an activity or event, we will contact you.

Scholarship Committee: Volunteers select recipients of two scholarships by reading essays.

Science Fair: (several volunteers needed) Volunteers are needed during the school day to help set up tables, balloons, and student display boards. During the evening event, volunteers will monitor the students as they walk through the gym to view the exhibits and answer any questions parents may have about the event. Any 4th and 5th grade student may enter a project in the Science Fair.

Teacher Appreciation: (several volunteers needed) Volunteers will be needed during Teacher Appreciation week to provide homemade or store-bought items to the Allenwood School staff for breakfast, lunch, or special treat. In addition, a few volunteers will be needed to help set-up, serve, and clean-up on the day of the celebration. This celebration takes place in either April or May.

Theatre Club: (several volunteers needed) PTG presents the annual play. Volunteers are needed to help at after school rehearsals with chaperoning and sign out. Volunteers are needed to assist at the performances in tickets, cast photo pick up, concession stand, ushering, backstage, and classroom chaperones. Volunteers may be needed to assist with costumes, props, lighting, sound and in other production areas. **Chairperson Position Available.**

Yearbook Photographer: This position requires you to take candid pictures of the students in the selected grade level throughout the year.

Yearbook Committee: Volunteers are needed to help with the back end of design for the yearbook. Tasks would include identify students in photos, photo selection, page layout design, work with photographers to gather photos and ensure photo design and help distribute yearbooks.
